Dan purchased a 1986 Graberner Press which had been used by the Denver Mint and was sold at an Auction in 2001 to an investor who later sold it to Dan in 2007. The press had been idle for six years and Dan had a formidable task to clean and prepare the press for his own use. Dan found over 400 blank plackets in various sections of the machine as well as a few stuck coins, mostly Kennedy half dollars in the oil pan. Dan designed his own dies and had commemorative tokens made from all the blank plackets. It took Dan almost a year to fully restore the press, which he now uses for all his own work. Dan is the artist who designed the reverses for the New York and Rhode Island State quarters.
