Program:

Dan Eicher gave a presentation on modern commemorative coins that were produced by the US Mint from 1982 to present. The first coin was a 90% silver half dollar that commemorated the 250th anniversary of George Washington's birth and was the first 90% silver coin produced by the US Mint since 1964. This was followed by the multi-coin commemorative set for the 1983-1984 Olympics which included the first gold coin struck by the US Mint in more than 50 years. During the presentation, Dan explained that the commemorative coins were minted to demand only for the year that they were issued. For some of the coins, this led to very low mintages making some of the coins very valuable to collectors. Dan concluded his presentation by showing several images of his commemorative coin collection which included the 1988 \$5 gold coin that had the image of Nike, the Greek goddess of Victory. The obverse of this coin is reminiscent of the images of Liberty that were on gold coins through the early part of the 20th century.
